To Kill A Mocking Bird will be making its official premiere at The Drama Centre from 26th February 2010. Due to overwhelming responses, 7 more shows has been added for audiences to catch the debut of the most enthralling show of the year.

A visual and artistic feast for the senses, To Kill A Mocking Bird is an exploration of human morality and presents a constant conversation regarding the inherent goodness or evilness of people. It is an awe-inspiring production by Toy Factory which mixes the simplicity of childhood observation with adult situations and complicated by hidden motivations and unquestioned tradition. The story highlights the serious issues of rape and racial inequality in the South America since the Civil War and Reconstruction. The show also addresses issues on class distinction, courage, compassion and prejudices.

Adapted from a Pulitzer-Prize winning novel by Harper Lee, this modern American Literature is the most widely novels being read by students around the world. British librarians ranked the book ahead of the Bible as one "every adult should read before they die ".
